

# Jersey Wado Ryu – Code of Conduct

## Purpose

This Code of Conduct sets out the standards of behaviour expected at Jersey Wado Ryu. It supports safeguarding, equality, diversity and inclusion, and aligns with Jersey Sport Safe & Sustainable Sport expectations.

## Who This Applies To

This Code applies to all instructors, volunteers, members, parents, carers and spectators involved in Jersey Wado Ryu activities.

## Expected Behaviour

- Treat everyone with respect, dignity and fairness
- Promote a safe, inclusive and positive environment
- Listen to and respect the views of children and young people
- Follow club policies, including safeguarding and EDI policies
- Use appropriate language and behaviour at all times
- Respect instructors, officials and volunteers
- Challenge poor behaviour and report concerns appropriately

## Children and Young People

All adults must:

- Act as positive role models
- Never use bullying, intimidation or inappropriate language
- Never ignore or dismiss a child's concern
- Follow the club's safeguarding procedures at all times

## Parents and Guardians

Parents and guardians are expected to:

- Support the club's values and policies
- Encourage positive behaviour
- Respect coaching decisions
- Raise concerns calmly and appropriately

## Breaches of the Code

Breaches of this Code of Conduct will be taken seriously and may result in action under the club's disciplinary or safeguarding procedures.
